Artevani Wines are made exclusively from organically grown Saperavi grapes with the use of the latest technologies and in compliance with ancient Georgian traditions and principles of **Organic Farming**:

- Single-vineyard grapes are used in the wine production.
- No use of chemical fertilizers.
- Grown in rows, grapes receive micronutrients from the nutrient-rich soil and neighbouring plants.
- · Grapes are hand-picked and only the best are selected.
- Quality control at all stages: growing, harvesting, transporting, production, storing and bottling.
- Equipment for the development of this wine is made from highest grade stainless steel and oak.
- No use of flavorings, preservatives, colorings and other food additives.
- Only the minimum amount of sulfites is used in the process of vinification.

Live vitamins and minerals are not lost during the processing.

Kakheti is Georgia's main wine-producing region in the country's east. Wine grapes have been cultivated in these lands for 8,000 years, which, archaeologists say, makes Kakheti the cradle of wine. According to the "Law of Georgia on Vine and Wine" Kakheti can be divided into 2 main sub-areas: Inner Kakheti and Outer Kakheti. Out of registered 18 appellation wines 14 belong to Kakheti. History of viticulture that can't be divided from the history of Kakheti takes start from VI millennium BC. Grape leftovers, discovered by the



archeologists, date back to the mentioned period and they are the oldest around the world. Viticulture is the most important part of social life, that's why this region is famous for vineyards and unique wine making traditions. High quality traditional and European wines can be produced from Kakhetian grape sorts. During the centuries Kakhetian inhabitants took care of vine with great tender and affection, wine making technologies were transferred from generation to generation. European scientists have conducted research and found an evidence of wine culture penetration from the territory of Georgia to the European countries. This is quite a powerful argument in favor of the statement that Georgia is the oldest wine country.

Kvevri - also known as Churi in Western Georgia are large earthenware vessels used for the fermentation, storage and ageing of traditional Georgian wine. Resembling large, egg-shaped amphorae without handles, they are either buried below ground or set into the floors of large wine cellars. Kvevri vary in size: volumes range from 20 to 10,000 liters. The process of making wine in Kvevri involves pressing the grapes and then pouring the juice, grape skins, stalks and pips into the Kvevri, which is then sealed. The juice is then left to ferment into wine for at least five to six months before being decanted and bottled.

Climat - the most favorable climatic and geographical conditions for the cultivation of grapes are observed in Alazani Valley, a unique area of Kakheti. This amazing valley stretches 110 miles from the north-west to the southeast at an altitude of 250-500 meters above the sea level between the main Caucasus and Tsiv-Gomborgskimi ridges. Excellent soils of the valley and a unique geographical location create exceptional conditions for the cultivation of grapes. Alazani Valley is home to such well-known grape varieties as "Saperavi" which in Georgian means "dye" and "Rkatsiteli" which means "red horn"
