After 1991 the founder of Kakhuri Gvinis Marani started reclaiming the family owned vineyards that were confiscated from his ancestors by the Soviet authorities in 1920s. In 2005 the company built a new winery in Gurjaani in the center of Kakheti.





Tondo with the image of St. Father

Gelati, silver covered with gold, diameter 20 sm., Museum of Art, Medieval Georgian engraving art. Xi century.



Rusudar

A large amount of coins was issued during the reign of Queen Tamar's daughter - Queen Rusudan. The mostly extraordinary is a silver coin cut in 1230.

The coin is decorated with the Georgian engraving - "Rusudan, the queen of the queens, the beauty of the world and religion. Rusudan, the daughter of Tamar, the admirer of Messiah".



Kolkhetian tetri

The head of the lion, turned to the left (There are only three coins, known in the world. They are preserved in State Museums in Haague, Britain and Georgia.)



The coin issued by King Giorgi III

The coin Issued during the reign of King Giorgi III (1156-1184AD). The coin is decorated by Georgian and arabic letters. On the secon side of the coin is written in arabic "King of the Kings Giorgi, son of Demetre, the sword of the Christ." The copper coin depicts King Giorgi II who has the hawk siting on his right hand. The coin is preserved in Mr. Simon Janashia's name Georgian National Museum.



Giorgi III and Tamar

The coin is issued in 1178. The following words can be read on the coin: "Giorgi. God, praise the king of the kings. "Tamar. God, praise the king and the queen."



Tamar - the coin issued on 1187

On the one side of this copper coin the sign of Tamar is clearly visible together with the Georgian symbols. On the other side of the coin we can see the words in Arabic: "The great queen, the beauty of the world and religion - Tamar, the daughter of Giorgi, the admirer of Messiah. God, praise her power, her glory, her shade and let her wealth be straightened".



Akhalgori treasure

Gold jewelry (temper hangs, earrings, the extraordinary samples of Georgian goldsmiths of Antic era. These type of coins are currently found only in Georgia.)



Golden cup

Golden cup. XIX-XVIII centuries. BC. Trialeti, Tsalka. The cup is made using one sheet of gold has double layered wall and hollow stand. The golden nests are filled with cornelians, lazurites, red jaspers, agates, glass paste.

Griffin barrel

Samtavisi church. ShidaKartli. Griffin barrel.

Samtavisi church, by its planning and structure, refers to the finest monuments of ShidaKartli XI century constructions, like Kavtiskhevi, Ertatsminda and Ikorti churches and all of them represent the mostly beautiful carvings. According to the scientist, academic M. Brosse, Samtavisi eastern facade is decorated with the luxurious ornament and it must be considered to be one of the most beautiful monuments in Georgia.



David IV copper coin, type-king in the empire clothing.

Front - The image of David Aghmashenebeli, with beard and wearing empire clothing is presented in anaphase. He has a long scepter in his right hand. He holds a sphere in his left hand, which is decorated with the cross. The upper part of the crown is also decorated with the cross. The king is wearing necklase.

David the king of Aphkhasians, Georgians, Rans, Kakhs, Armenians.



Copper Giorgi IV Lasha 1207-1210

Giorgi IV Lasha (born in 1192 - passed away on January 18th 1223) - Georgian king in 1213-1223. Son of queen Tamar and David Soslan.

Tamar made him a king and gave his the right to participate in countries' governing since 1207. His lands were located in Javakheti, and that is why he is being called Javakh Prince on the coins of that period. After Tamar passed away, Giorgi IV became sole governor. His will was to straighten king's power, keep the unity of the country and integrate the sworn countries, which were trying to escape from the control of Georgia.



Coin of queen Mariam, the year 1070

The king Bagrat and his second wife Borena sent their daughter Marta to Constantinople, to get an appropriate education, in 1056. Another cup in the Byzantine Kingdom was discovered in 1078. Michael Doukas Parapinakēs was made to retire to the monastery and Nikephoros III Botaneiates (1078-1083) was announced to be an emperor.

In 1081, Alexios Komnenos helped by Mariam, managed to dismiss Nikephoros III Botaneiates from the throne and become a new emperor. Alexios Komnenos was adopted by the queen in order to announce his son co-emperor, together with Constantine. Bizantinian history does not know any case, when the former wife of the emperor keeps all her rights. Only Mariam remained in all her rights and it was her honor, even more, she experienced all her privileges and powers.

It is known, that in 1104, Marta visited Georgia and attended Ruisi-Urbnisi meeting, accompanied by her brother (Giorgi II) and nephew (David Aghmashenebeli).

She is buried in one of the monasteries, nearby Trakia. The land belonged to her and was given to her by Alexios Komnenos.



Pirosmani

Niko Pirosmanashvili, is a Georgian primitive artist, born in 1862 in Mirzaani and passed away in 1918 in Tbilisi.

The works of Pirosmanashvili were presented on I Big Georgian Exhibition, held in Tbilisi in 1918. In 1920th, Georgian press had published letters, addressed to him, as well the special collection, dedicated to him. The interest towards Pirosmani especially grew after 1950th - the related books were published in Georgia, Russia and foreign countries. The biographic movie was shot; different related theatre plays and musical performances were held. The exhibition of Pirosmani works was organized in different towns of former USSR as well as the cities of different Western European countries. The greatest part of artist's works is now preserved in Georgian State Art Museum and different private collections abroad.
