## VINEYARDS

Schild Estate vineyards are spread over 9 unique sites in the Southern Barossa.

The patchwork of soils and diverse meso-climates create a tapestry of vineyards that permit a wide range of varieties to be grown to their full potential.





## SOUTHERN BAROSSA

Vineyard site selection has favoured the cooler, southern end of the Barossa.

This allows for slower, longer ripening periods and optimum flavour development.

## MOOROOROO VINEYARD

This irreplaceable vineyard was planted by Johan and William Jacob in 1847, just eleven years after the foundation of South Australia. These ancient vines are now over 168 years old – some of the oldest vines in the world.

The vines concentrate the characteristics of the single vineyard into a wine of rare complexity and intensity of character and elegance only found in the highest quality wines.



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In recognition of the integrity of Moorooroo and its importance in the Barossa, this wine has been awarded the Barossa Trust Mark.

An honour conferred on Barossan products and experiences which meet exceptional standards across five key values: quality, integrity, origin, community and environment.

# ICON AND LUXURY SELECTION

## Moorooroo Limited Release Ancient Vine Shiraz

The dark plum fruit and vanilla bean aromas evident on the nose are also prominent as flavours on the palate.

Here they fill out the mouth and roll all the way though to a long and lingering finish. A bright acid structure and some fine tannins provides a clear frame and direction of travel ensuring a genuinely balanced feel to the palate.

## SPECIAL RELEASES

### Prämie Special Release Shiraz

Small batch hand picked, specific vineyard wines produced when there is an outstanding parcel of fruit in a vintage.

Full, soft and layered with aromas of vibrant blackberries and blood plum fruit. These are coupled with secondary more subtle hints of cedar wood, fresh vanilla bean, pan forte and clove spice.

# SPARKLING COLLECTION

## Sparkling Chardonnay Pinot Noir and Sparkling Shiraz

Sparkling shiraz has been part of the Schild Estate family's stable of wines right from the early days. The soft dark berry fruit, fine tannins and vibrant acid so often seen in Shiraz sourced around Lyndoch made Schild Estate an ideal area to make red fizz.

As Ed Schild's daughters Judy and Leanne play an increasingly important role in the estate, the request naturally came for a sparkling white wine to complement the lively banter of the Schild family get together.
