AT SCHILD ESTATE YOU CAN STILL SHAKE HANDS WITH FAMILY MEMBERS FROM THREE GENERATIONS WHO HAVE BECOME THE FAMILY'S HEART.

Schild Estate wines are created with authenticity and passion. From real earth in the Southern Barossa by generations of a family who have made that place their home.

Ed Schild has been the driving force behind Schild Estate right from its creation. Whilst he still steers the ship today, he is slowly handing some of the reigns over to his children and getting to enjoy life a bit more away from the vineyards and the winery. It therefore seemed an appropriate moment to acknowledge his hard work and dedication by making a wine named in his honour. The only challenge was to find a vineyard and a wine that was up to the task.

Ed's love of the old vines of the Barossa, coupled with an appreciation of the merits of Grenache from this part of the world steered us towards two patches of old bush vines located high on the eastern hills overlooking Rowland Flat. Here the 88–98 year old dry grown, low yielding vines are exposed to the elements, are particularly hardy and consistently deliver the goods. A bit like Ed himself.

An exciting new project for the family and for the viticulture and winemaking team and one we will look to develop and refine over future vintages.

Winemaker's Notes

Colour: Deep dark cherry

Bouquet: Layered and structured with dark perfumed fresh berry fruit supported by secondary notes of ground pepper and subtle more earthy traces of fresh Kalamata olives, exotic cardamom and turmeric spice and preserved lemons. Gravitas and depth without losing freshness.

Palate: Soft vibrant berry fruit fills out front and mid palate with texture, refreshing aromatics and pepper spice supported all the time by a fine subtle tannin frame constantly lifting and framing the wine. The result is some lovely movement through the mouth before finishing structured, clean and without dryness.
