

## Chateau Mezain Red



**Grape:** 50% Merlot, 50 % Cabernet

**Color:** Garnet with fuchsia highlights

**Nose:** Powerful, fruity, persistent nose with black currant aromas and cherries

**Palate:** Subtle, ample, persistent mouth with notes of bilberry jam.

**Serve with** grilled red meat and cheese.



## Chateau Mezain White



**Grape:** 100% Sauvignon

**Color:** Pale yellow, shimmering with grey highlights.

**Nose:** Powerful bouquet, complex and persistent with aromas of berries and grapefruit.

**Palate:** Well-balanced palate, round and lively, with citrus notes.



## Chateau Dumas Cenot Bordeaux Superior



**Grape:** 33% Merlot – 67% Cabernet

**Color:** Ruby with great intensity.

**Nose:** Expressive smell of matured black fruits.

**Palate:** Supple tannins with a ripe fruit. Well-balanced wine with a long persistent finish.

**Serve with** grilled red meat and cheese.



## Côtes du Rhône Reserve de l'Abbé



**AOC** Côtes du Rhône,

**Grape:** 70% Grenache & 30% Syrah

A beautiful ruby red wine. Very fragrant, with aromas of red fruit (currant, strawberry and cherry) and hints of black pepper and cinnamon.

Medium-bodied and silky in the mouth with mature, round tannins.



## Domaine de Tholomies



Vin de Pays D'Oc

**Grape :** Cabernet-Sauvignon, Merlot

**Color:** A bright garnet red color with pretty violet reflections.

**Nose:** Wonderful scents of dark fruit

**Palate:** Very fresh and generous on the palate, with remarkable fullness and balance.

**Serve with** salads, fish, grilled mix.



## Château Petit Roubié Picpoul de Pinet



A golden colored white wine with brilliant pearly green reflections.

The complex nose combines the dominant aroma of flowers with the scent of white peach and the exotic flavor of pineapples.

Initially round and full the taste rapidly changes to lively.

Great with oysters, assorted fruit de mer or grilled seafood.
