

# Composition



Cabernet Sauvignon < 5% Petite Sirah



Lovely blend of grapes from the Paso Robles appellation and subava, Estrella district. Cabernet Sauvignon grapes sourced for this vintage are known for their big & bold, value-driven Cabs that are drinkable now or laid-down to age.

### Temp/Rain



Mediterranean climate consisting of warm days and cool nights averaging 68° and a diurnal temp variance up to 40° between April & October. Average rainfall 13.5″.

#### Harvest



The 2016 vintage experienced a good harvest delivering higher yields, high quality fruit and high color density than the previous four drought-laden vintages.

### The Wine



Distinct, bright raspberry aromas lead to hammy cherry and espresso notes with hints of caramel & cedar. The finish is firm yet balanced, and framed by mouthwatering acidity. Alcohol 13.8% French Oak
