Paso Robles is well known for their Rhône-style varietals and the western hilly areas host five sub-AVA's such as Adelaida, Paso Robles Willow Creek, & Templeton Gap offering idyllic growing conditions to support Rhône blends.

Temp/Rain



Mediterranean climate consisting of warm days and cool nights averaging 68° and a diurnal temp variance up to 40° between April & October. Average rainfall 25".

Harvest



The 2016 vintage was a good harvest year delivering higher yields, high quality fruit and high color density than the previous four drought-laden vintages.

The Wine



Deep red in color and with lush aromas of blueberry and vanilla, this well-balanced wine displays subtle tannins and intense blackcurrant and cinnamon flavors alongside toasty oak notes on the long complex finish
