



Vintage: 100% 2017

Appellation: 95% single vineyard located on the eastern border of the Sacramento Delta.

Varietals: 95% Pinot Noir, 5% Petite Sirah

Vineyard: We do not disclose specific vineyards as the vineyard owners will refuse to do business with us in the future. In some cases we are forced to sign nondisclosure agreements. So the name of the specific vineyard like all Sola wines must remain unknown. Because of the vineyards location, on the eastern border of the entire Sacramento delta, the grapes get morning fog and evening breezes along with a soil that is rich in minerals.

Cooperage: Primarily stainless steel tanks with the use of medium toasted French oak staves.
